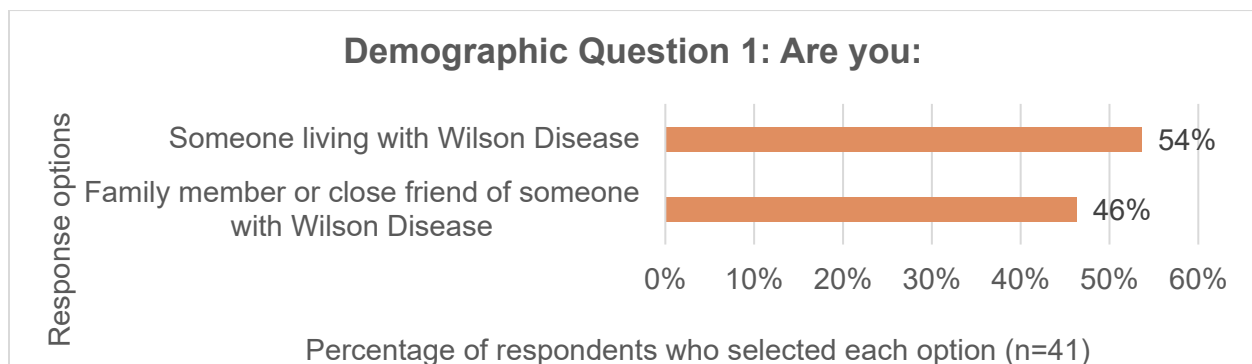

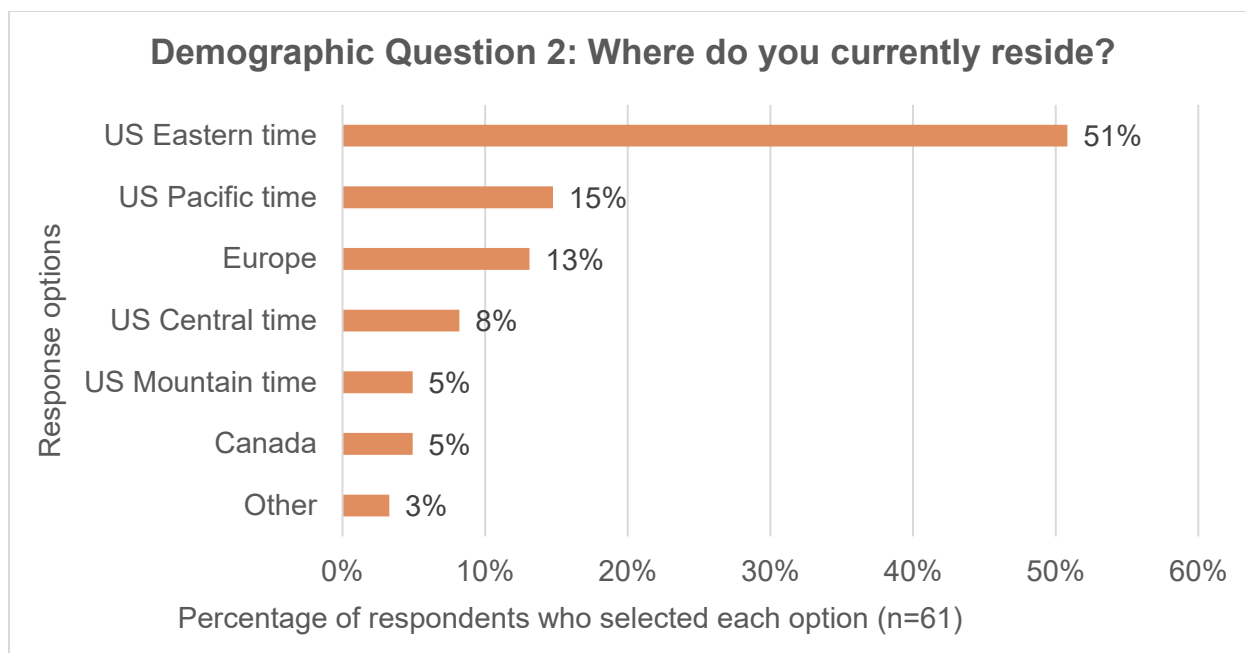

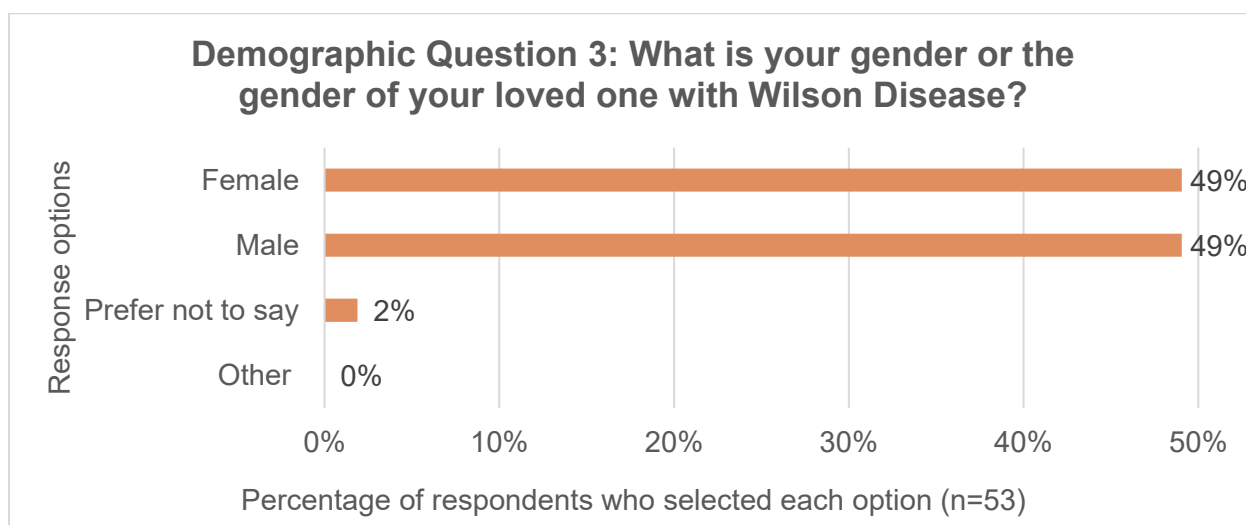
Demographic Questions

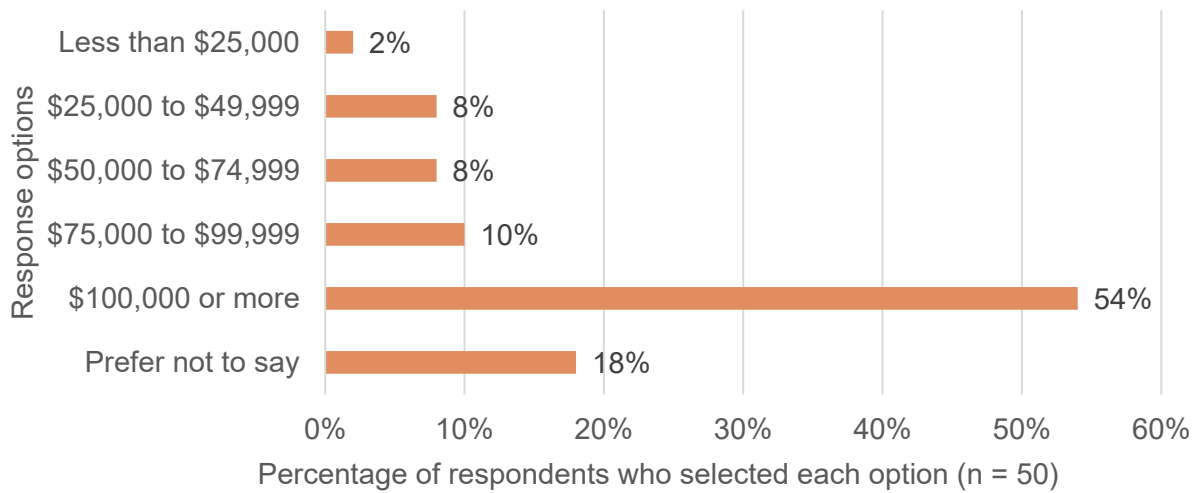




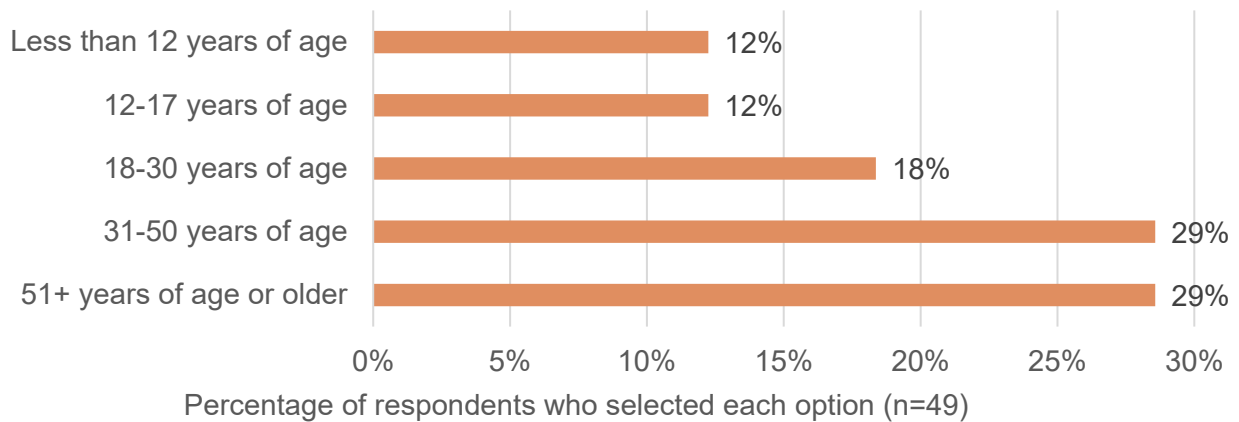
At the time of polling there were no poll responses from Mexico, Central America, South America and Caribbean, Asia or Middle East.



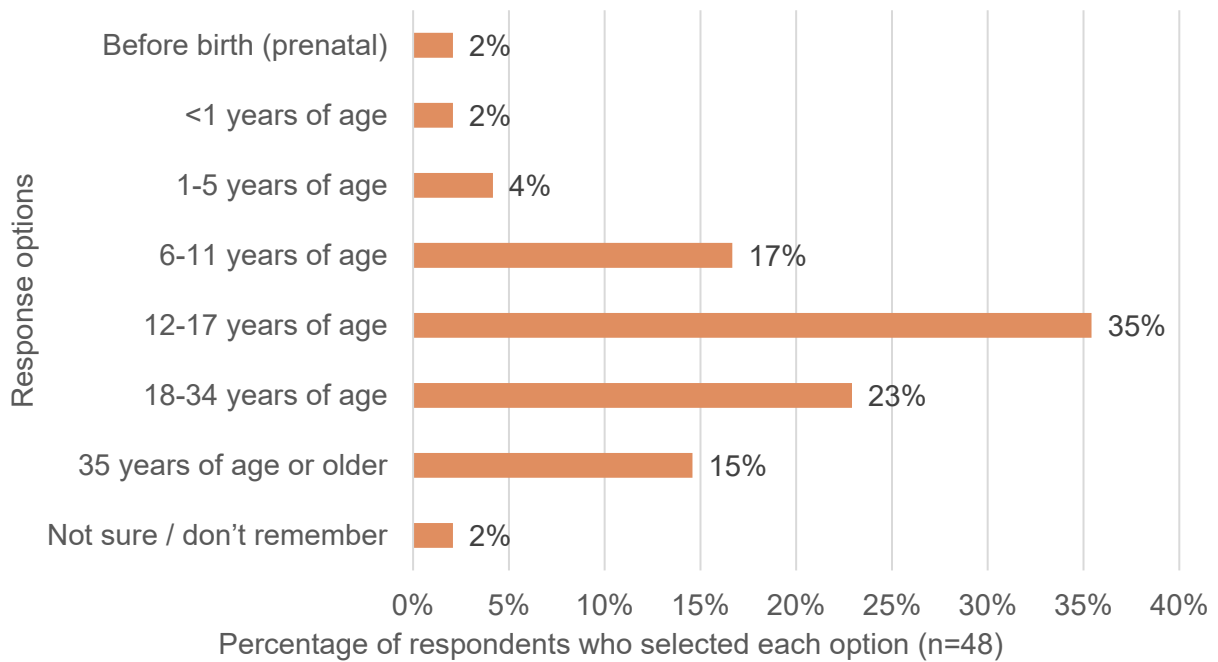
Demographic Question 4: What is your annual family/household's income before taxes?



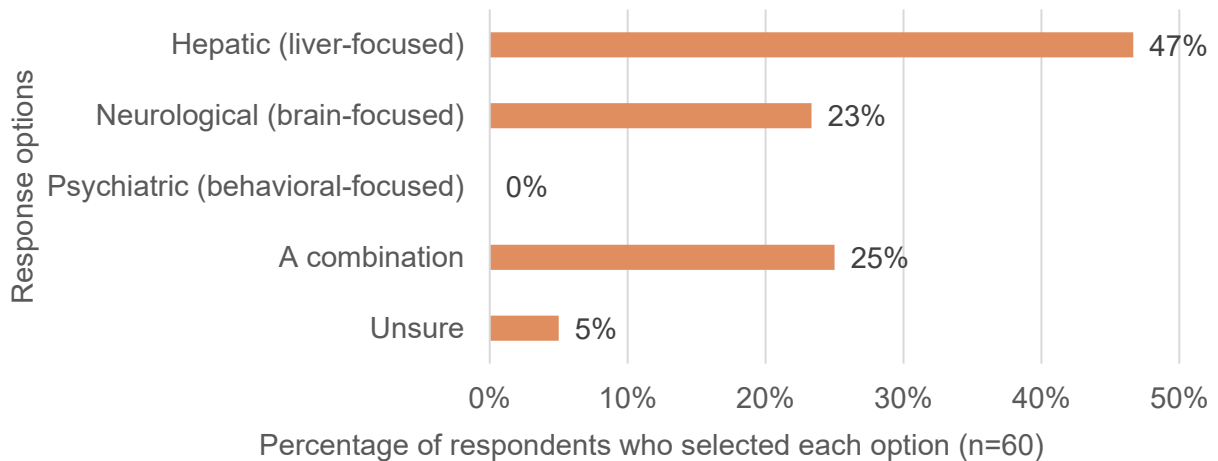
Demographic Question 5: How old are you or your loved one with Wilson Disease (or age they passed away)?



Demographic Question 6: At what age were you or your loved one diagnosed with Wilson Disease?

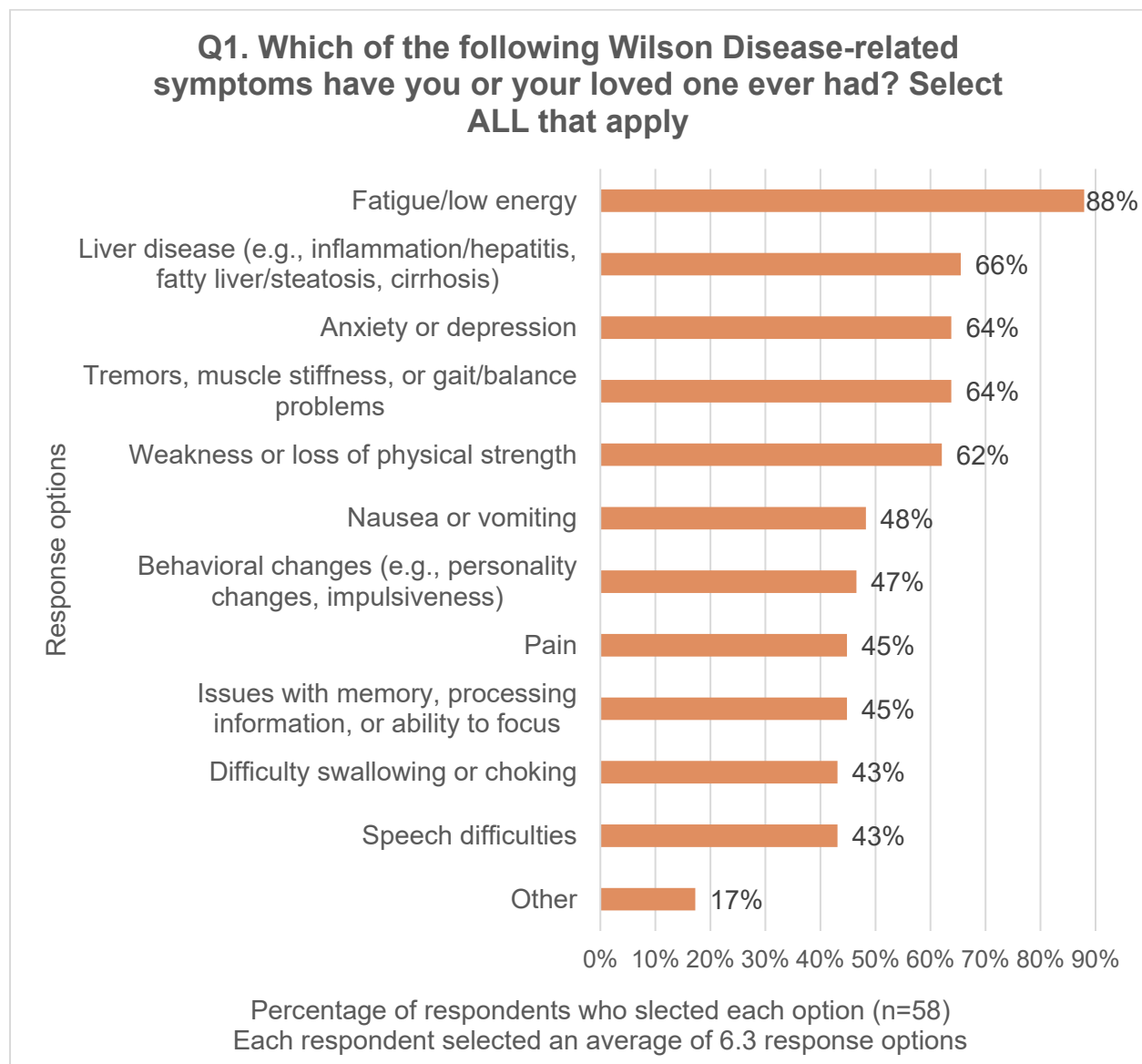


Demographic Question 7: What type of Wilson Disease are you or your loved one experiencing?

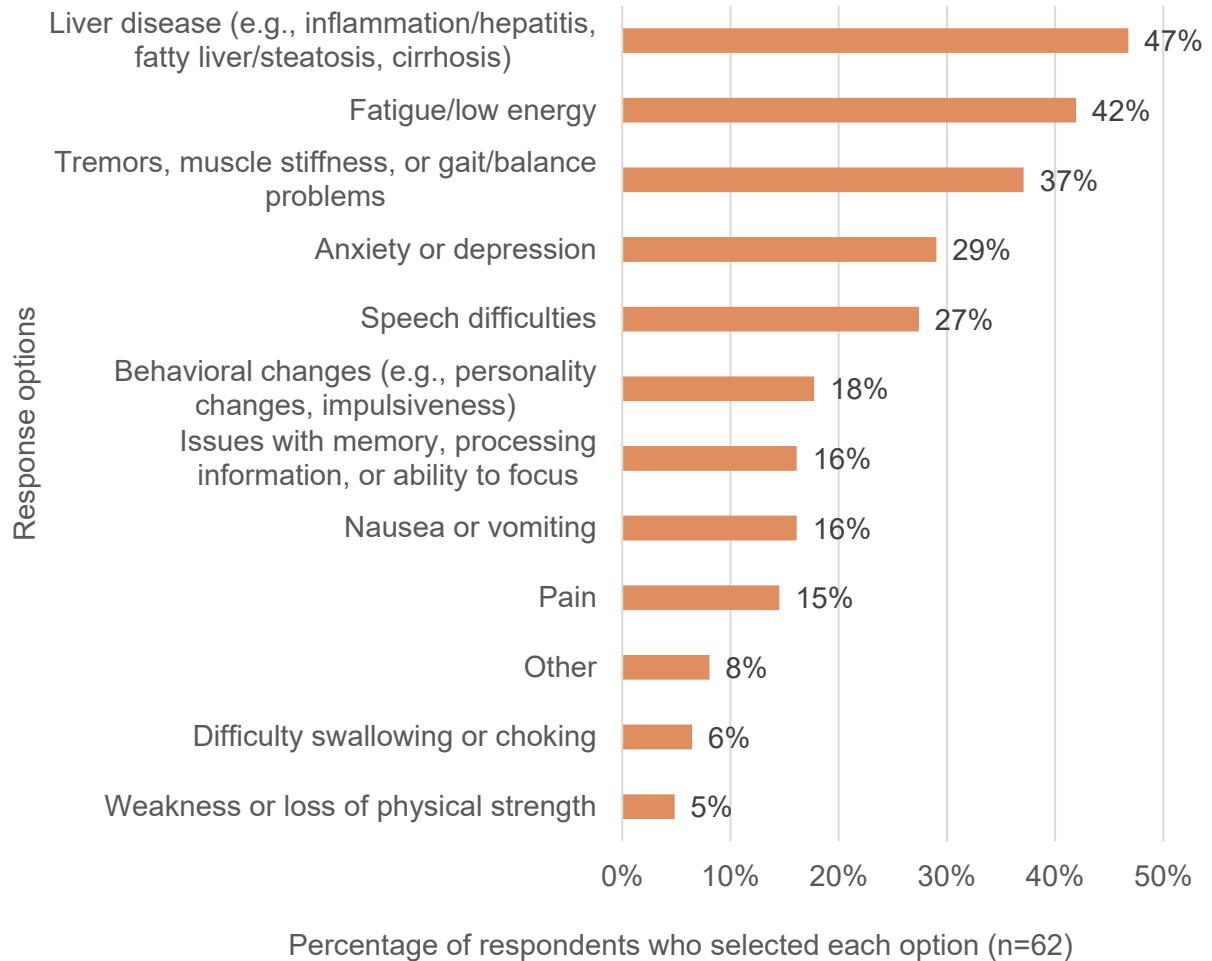


Poll Responses to Topic 1: Wilson Disease Symptoms and Daily Impacts

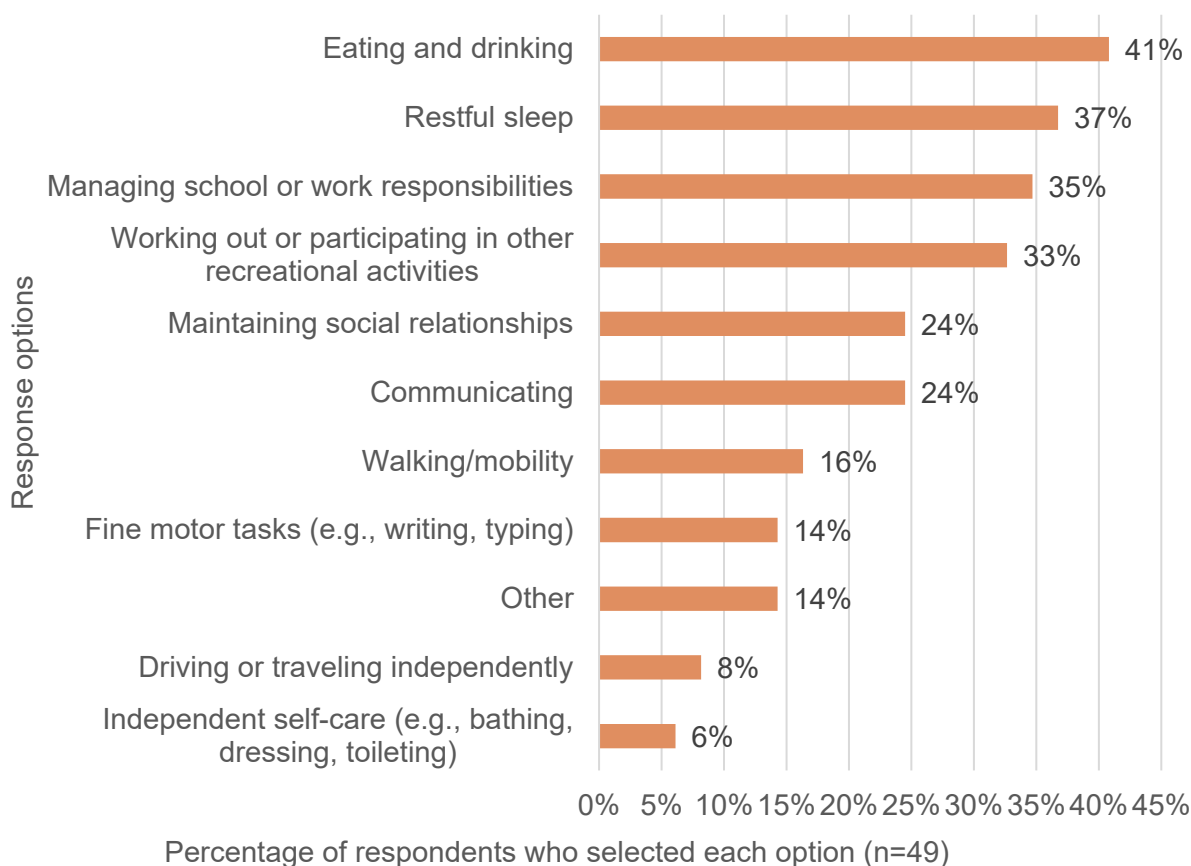
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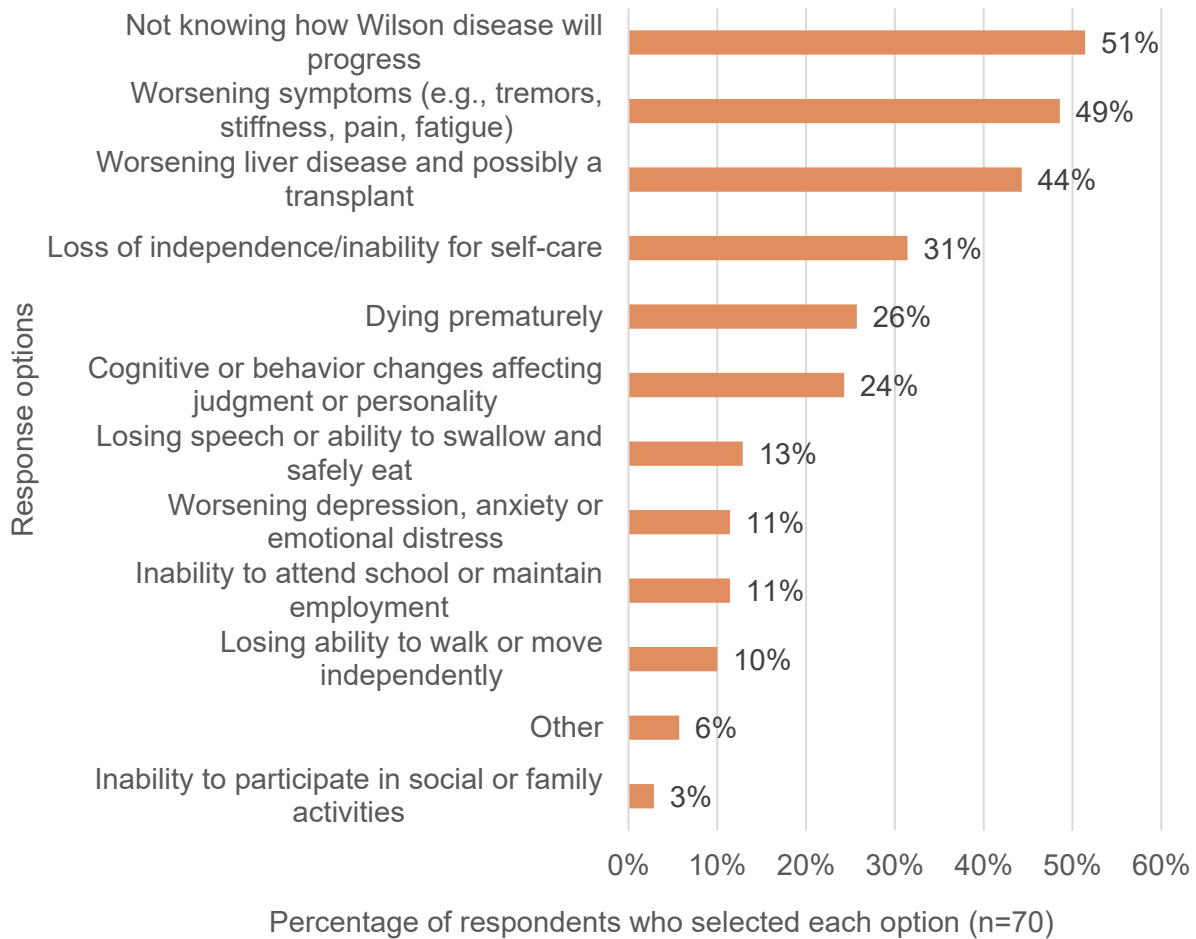
Q2. Select the most troublesome Wilson Disease-related symptoms that you or your loved one have had. Select TOP 3.



Q3. What specific activities of daily life are most important that you or your loved one are NOT able to do or struggle with due to Wilson Disease? Select TOP 3.

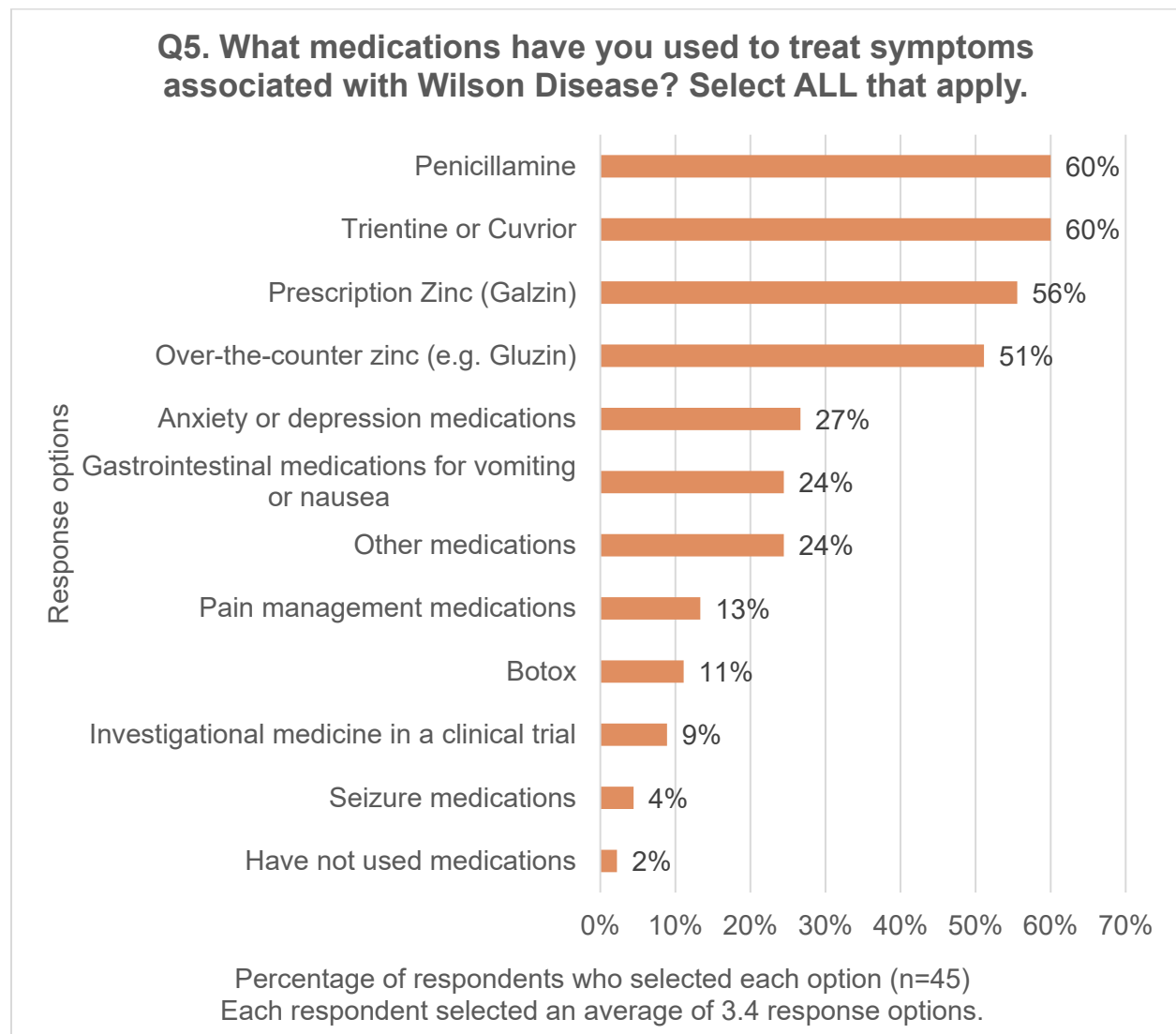


Q4. What worries you most about your or your loved one's condition in the future? Select TOP 3.

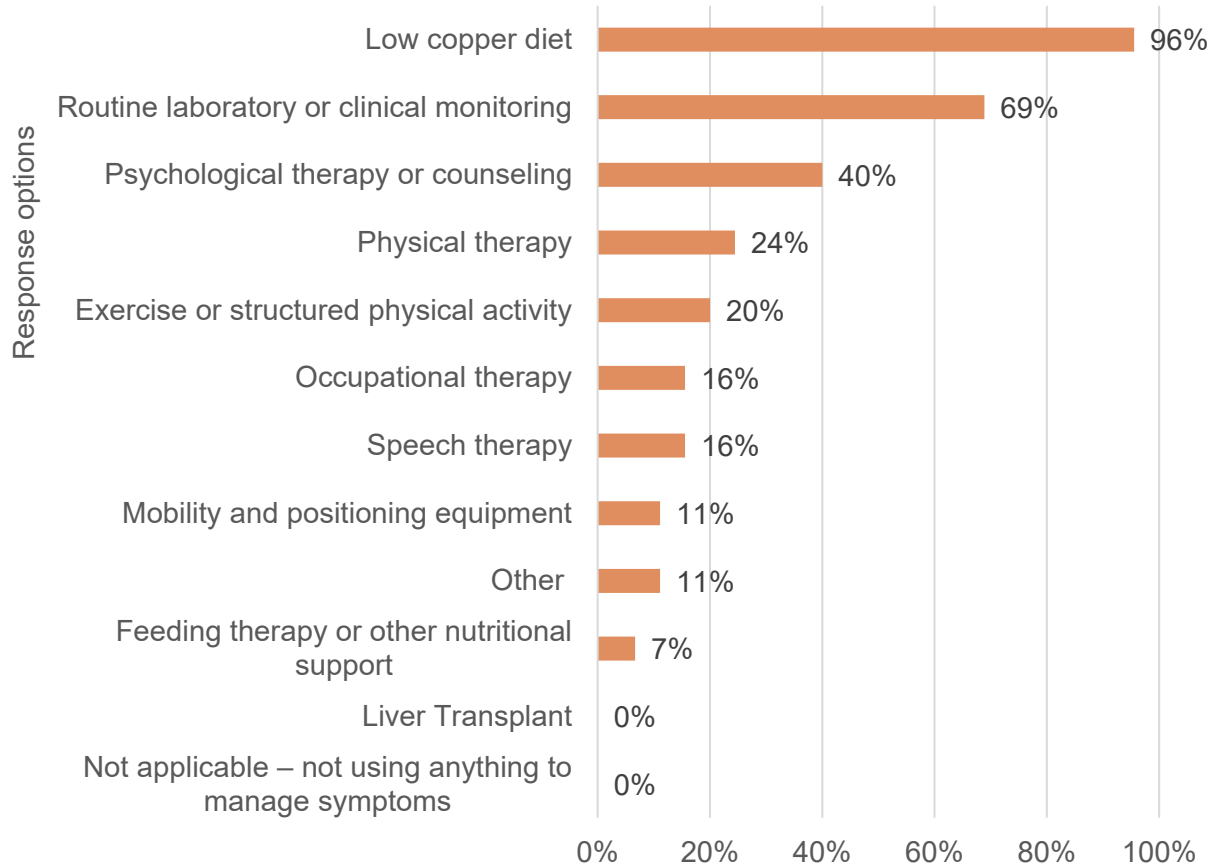


Poll Responses to Topic 2: Current and Future Approaches to Wilson Disease Treatment

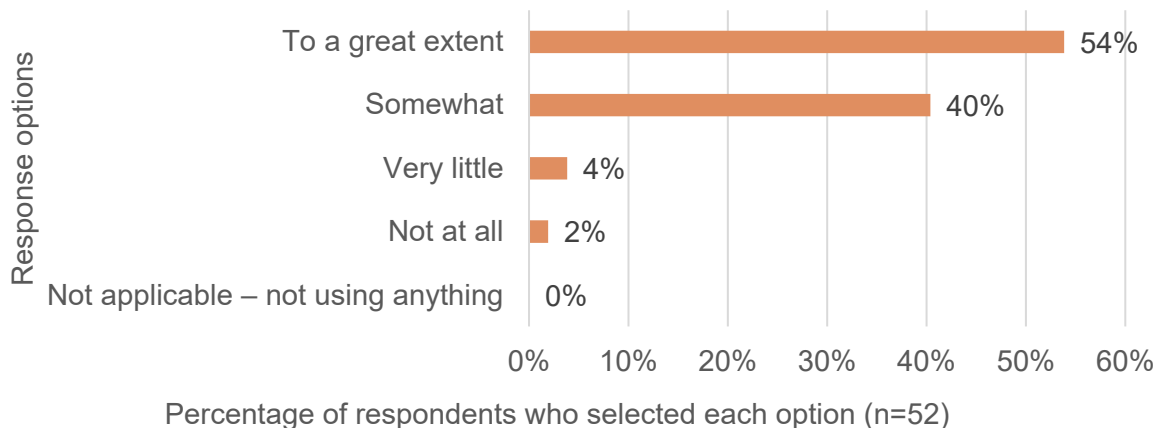


Q6. Besides medications, what other approaches have you used to help treat or manage the symptoms of Wilson Disease? Select ALL that apply.

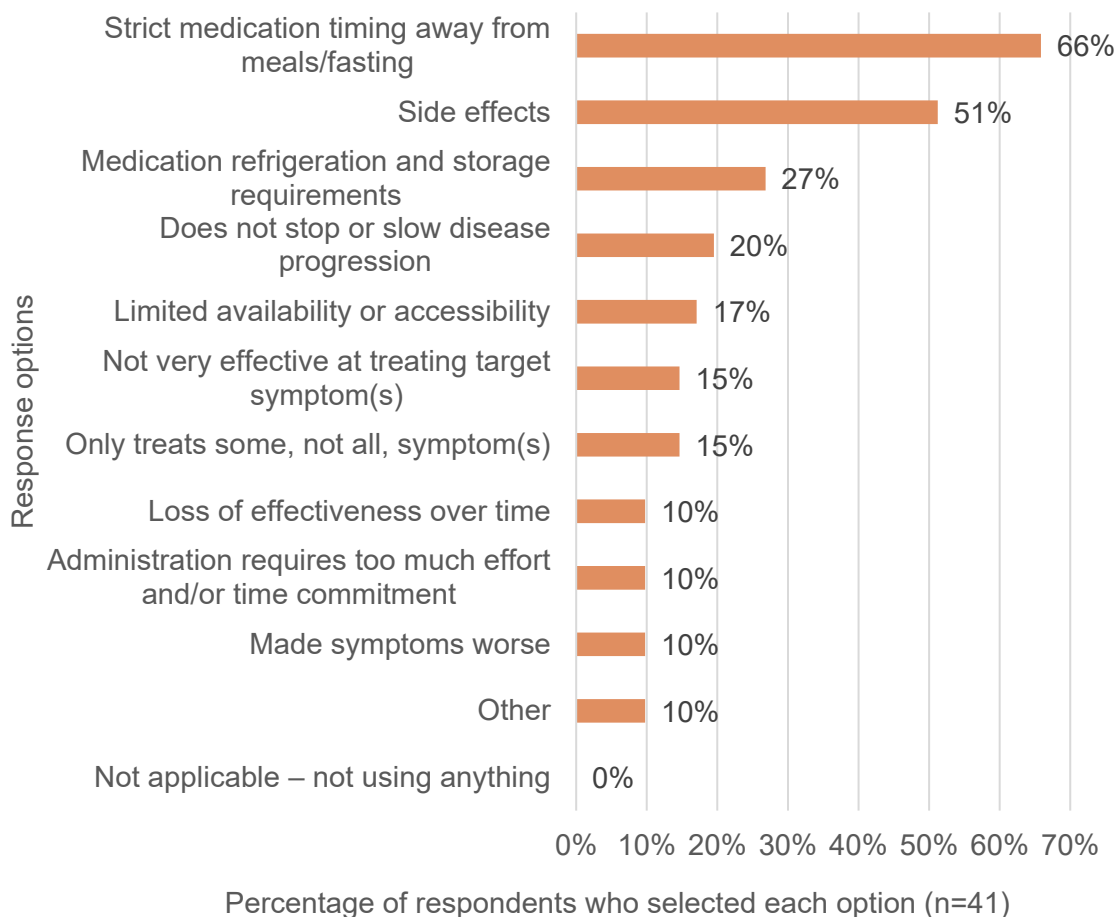
